Run Madtown Pregnancy and Post- Partum Policy

Run Madtown participants who become pregnant or have given birth since registering for Run Madtown are eligible to defer their entry and fee to a future Run Madtown event, within a three-year window. For example, if you register for the 2024 Run Madtown event and become pregnant, you can defer your registration to the 2025, 2026 or 2027 Run Madtown events.

Registered participants requesting a deferral under this policy must email Beth@runmadtown.com by MAY 1st. Run Madtown reserves the right to extend the deadline under certain circumstances. A doctor's note is **not** required.

Registered participants going through adoption or surrogacy, or who have a partner who is pregnant, are eligible to defer their entry as well, please email Beth@runmadtown.com by May 1st.

Registered participants requesting a deferral should be aware of the following:

- The deferred entry is specific to you and may not be transferred to any other person.
- You must register during future Run Madtown event application windows.
- A special "how to register" email will be sent to anyone who defers under this policy when registration for the next year opens.
- For example, your 2024 event entry fee will be deferred to a future event (2025, 2026 or 2027). If there is an increase in the event entry fee (for your specific event distance), you will *not* be required to pay the difference. If you registered for a shorter distance and now want to participate in a longer distance, there will be a difference in price that you will be required to pay.
- If you purchased additional items with your registration (merchandise or race day packet pick up), those items are non-refundable and will not be applied to future participation. If you purchased merchandise, that can still be picked up during race week or can be shipped for an additional fee.
- Race dates for future Run Madtown events have not been finalized. Historically, Run Madtown has been held Saturday and Sunday of Memorial Day Weekend.
- Once this process has been completed, it cannot be undone. At our discretion, we will consider exceptions on a case-by-case basis.
- If an eligible participant cannot claim their guaranteed entry during the three-year window because of an additional pregnancy, they will be eligible for an additional deferral under the policy.
